GERMANS DENY FOCH MILITARY GENIUS

Was Ferdinand Foch a great military genius? The question is raised by the very general denial in the German press that he can claim to rank with Caesar, the Duke of Marlborough, Frederick the Great or Napoleon. The Allies have always supposed him to have been a great soldier, but we suppose that as a matter of fact there cannot be more than a dozen living men competent to give an opinion that might well record the verdict of history.

The Reigning Champion
The present writer disclaims any such qualifications for the task, and merely suggests that the custom is to ascribe great military gifts to the leaders who bring off great military victories. The winner is the champion, and Foch is the champion of modern warfare, waged on a world-wide scale, and will continue to be regarded as the champion until another such world war is waged under conditions approximating those under which he fought.

and his task was much lighter than the task of either Hindenburg or Ludendorff. Most of them seem to concentrate their remarks upon the fighting in the summer and autumn of 1918, and of course that spans most of the time when Foch was in supreme command of the Allies.

Was Germany's Foe
The comment of the German Press, enterprisingly collected by the New York Herald-Tribune, shows a marked bitterness to Foch. There is not much gallantry in the newspaper observations, no hailing of a great opponent. Foch instead is belittled as a military man conspicuously lacking in stature and is also anatomized as a bitter foe of Germany.

Not Military Overthrow
The dead marshal's German critics do not, of course, expose their own generals to the retort that if Foch lacked military genius German generals must have more abundantly lacked it since he proved their master. They do not admit that there was any military defeat at all. We recall that after the armistice when the German troops marched homeward they were greeted with acclaim as an undefeated army.

Sledge-Hammer Blows
In any event Wilson is not given credit for statesmanship nor Foch for military leadership. Even the naval engagement off Jutland is not admitted to have been a British victory. Foch, it is contended, merely picked the fruits which others had reaped. He continued his sledge-hammer attacks along the front, and they continued to grow stronger because fresh American troops were being poured into the ranks of the Allies.
