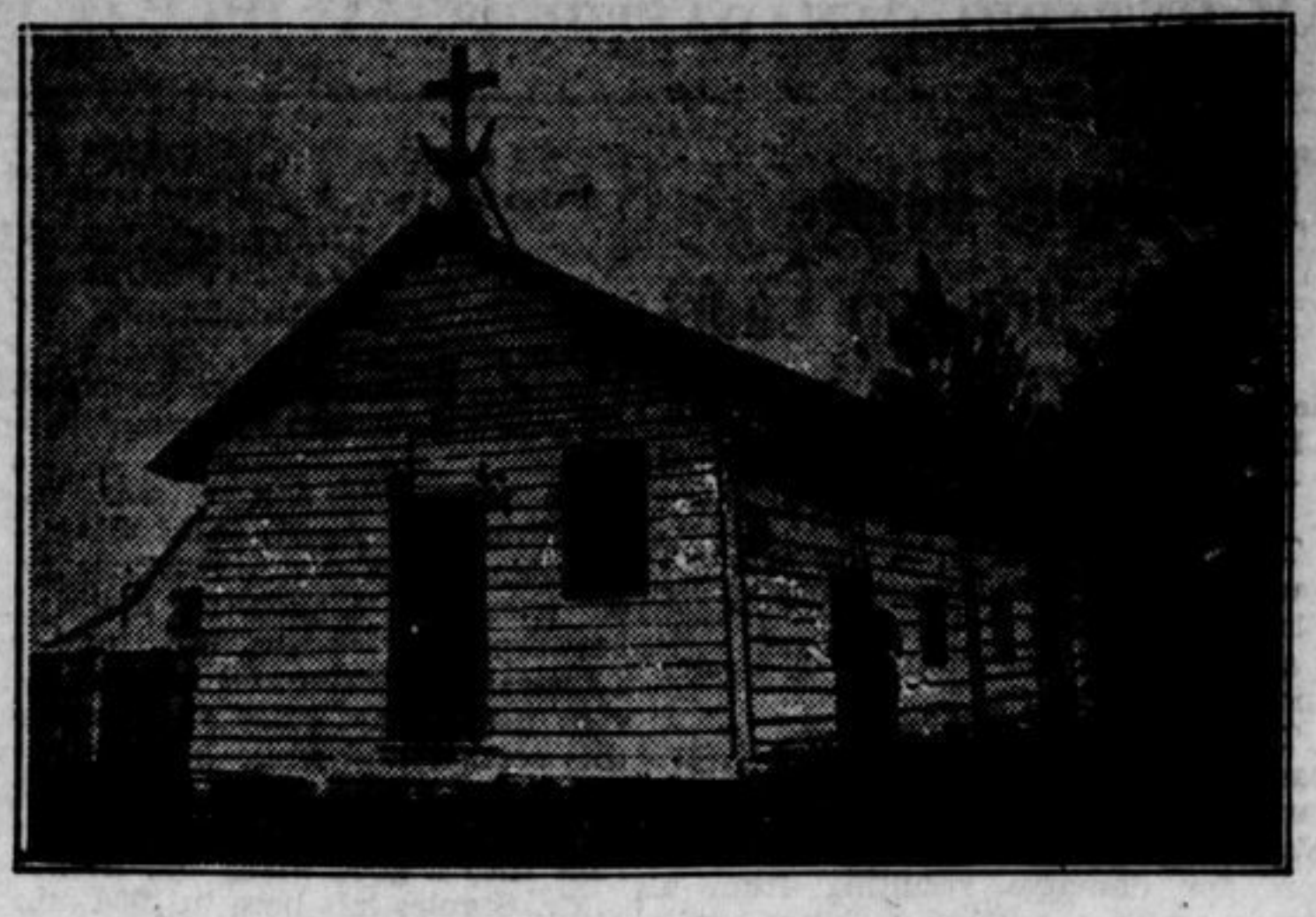
Run Over By Wagon
