EUGENIA FALLS DEVELOPMENT

Contract Let for Dam and Water Wheels—Four Hundred and Thirteen Feet Head.

We are advised by officers of the Georgian Bay Power Co., that the contract for building the big dam at Eugenia Falls has been awarded to the Ambursen Hydraulic Construction Co., of Montreal, the Canadian branch of the United States Ambursen Company, whose headquarters are at Boston.

The dam will consist of spillway, abutments and bulkheads. The spillway, built on solid rock bed, will be forty feet high and eighty feet long. The base (up and down stream) will be sixty-two and a half feet wide, and the crown ten feet wide.

The bulkheads from the abutments to the river banks rise to the forty-seven feet level. The one on the south side will be three hundred and fifteen feet long, the other one hundred and twenty feet.

The entire length of the dam from bank to bank will be about five hundred and forty feet at the upper level, and it will provide pondage for thirteen million cubic feet of water, necessitating the removal of the venser mill dam and building, the Miller sawmill dam and building and the Sloan sash and door factory dam and building, and backing the water up a considerable distance on the Sproule property above the Sloan dam.

by the company. There will thus be created a lake of considerable proportions, which will at least to some extent atone for the interference with the scenic beauty of the Falls, caused by diverting the water through the tunnel.

The dam is designed by the Company's chief engineer, Mr. H. Von Schon, Detroit, who was chief engineer for the development of fifty-six thousand horse power on the American side of the Soo, and who has charge of the entire development at Eugenia Falls.

Much consideration has been given the selection of the turbines, resulting in the contract going to a well known firm of manufacturers in Switzerland, which leads the world in engineering practice as regards water power development under high head.

The Eugenia Falls water power would be quite at home in a Swiss canton. While the four hundred and thirteen foot drop at Eugenia is the highest known here in Canada, it would be a modest head in Switzerland, where small streams properly handled produce from one thousand to ten thousand horse power, under head of from one hundred to three thousand feet, in some instances calling for tunnels thousands of feet in length, through solid rock.

The turbines under order for the Georgian Bay Power Co. are two in number, each of fifteen hundred horse power capacity, or three thousand horse power total. They will be mounted on horizontal shafts, and will run at a speed of six hundred revolutions per minute. It takes a powerful wheel to withstand the enormous pressure of water under a four hundred and thirteen foot head, each square inch of surface being subjected to a pressure of one hundred and seventy-three pounds.

If the stream, as it will strike the wheels at Eugenia, were turned upon the hillsides, the earth would fade away before it like snow before a jet of steam, and rocks the size of an average house would be whirled along as readily as a burr coming in the way of a stream issuing from an ordinary garden hose.
