#### BRUCE COUNTY RURAL 'PHONES

Farmers Offered These for \$12 Per Annum by Company Now Making Canvas.

(Toronto Star.)

Walkerton, April 27 .- A company, known as the Bruce Telephone Company, has been formed, and agents of the company are now going from place to place throughout the county, making contracts with the municipalities for the right to erect poles. This company is establishing "rural telephones," that is to say, they expect to get the bulk of their business by giving phone connection between farm house and farm house, and again between the farm houses and the towns and villages. Already the company has made an agreement with both the village of Teeswater and the Township of Culross, and in all prob ability will soon be negotiating with with Teeswater provides that the franchise is to expire at the end of 20 years, that subscribers are not to be charged more than \$12 a year, and that the company shall pay the village the sum of \$48 per year for the use of the streets
