SCHOOL GRANTS.

Education Departments' Announcement Regarding the Increased Allowance

The Education Department authorized the issue to inspectors and rural school boards of an announcement providing for the distribution of the increased grants passed at the last legistative session The Public and Separate Schools will this year secure Canada has one of the largest firms in organized counties a total of \$380of cattle exporters in the world in 000, an increase of \$200.000 over last year, while the district grants will be \$85.000, or double the amount

The Department has decided that the division of these increased grants will be based upon the salaries paid to teachers, the value of school equip ment, the character of accommodation and the grade of teachers secur-

la the organized counties \$20 extra will be paid in each case where a first or second-class certificate teacher is engaged, and in the unorganized dis tricts \$20 for each teacher having a professional district certificate, \$25 for each third-class certificate, \$30 Jury Return Verdict Exonerating for each second-class certificate and \$35 for each first-class certificate.

Special extra provisions for payments when good salaries are paid to teachers will be provided, and special grants to poor schools and grants for the building of schools in new districts where settlement is new. Five thousand dollars is also provided for rural school libraries, all o share alike in the distribution.


