CHEAPER SCHOOL BOOKS.

The tenders for the publication for eighteen months from June 30th next of the Public School Readers, has been awarded to the Canadian Publishing Company of this city.

COMPARISON OF PRICE.

The retail prices offered by the company are:—For the first reader, part one, five cents; part two, seven cents. Second reader, nine cents; third reader thirteen cents; fourth reader, fifteen cents.

The Canadian Publishing Company is one of the three firms now publishing the readers, the other two being the Copp, Clark Company and the W. J. Gage & Company.

THE SUCCESSFUL TENDER.

There were eight or nine tenders in all, and they were received in response to public advertisements. The text of the successful tender was given out by the Minister of Education, and is as follows:—

"In response to your advertisement for tenders for the supply of the Ontario series of readers, known as the Public School Readers, for use in the public schools of Ontario for the term of one and a half years from June 30, 1907.

"(a) We hereby offer and agree to supply the different books of the said series at the following retail prices:—For the First Reader (Part I), 5 cents; for the First Reader (Part II), 7 cents; for the Second Reader, 9 cents; for the Third Reader, 13 cents; for the Fourth Reader, 15 cents; the said books, each and all of them, to be of the standard of the samples submitted herewith.
