Professor A. B. MacCallum, Lecturer on Physiology to The Uni versity of Toronto:

"The results of careful experiments show that alcohol, taken in diluted form in small doses is oxidized within the body and so supplies energy like common articles of food; and that it is incorrect to designate it as a poison."

Professor P. H. Pye-Smith,

Lecturer to Guy's Hospital Medical School, London: "Malt liquors, for a large number of people (perhaps for most adults), do more good than harm when taken with

meals. Temperance is much better than Professor Lafayette B. Mendel, Yale University, New Haven: "Man is by nature a temperate animal,

and it is only by distinguishing between temperance and intemperance (i.e., use and abuse) that the evils of alcoholism can be combated. Present methods fail in this respect." Professor T. J. Clouston,

Edinburgh: "Alcohol is a food, and may in diluted form (as in beer) be a very valuable adjunct to ordinary foods, by exciting appetite, by improving digestion, and by stimulating certain nutritive processes, e.g., the laying on of fat."
