RAISING THE PIGS RIGHT

How to Get a Fair Profit Out of Swine.

Avoid Extremes of Heat and Sun—Using the Self-feeder—A Corrective for Winter Use—Farm Bookkeeping—Roughage: Have It Good.

(Contributed by Ontario Department of Agriculture, Toronto.)

Swine are profitable when given abundant sunshine and exercise, fed on well selected feeds, gently handled, given proper sanitation and housing, kept free from worms and lice, and protected against cholera and other diseases.

The Self-feeder for Pigs. Young pigs having access to a self-feeder may neglect the pasture portion of their rations, so must be watched from time to time.

Corrective for Winter Use. The use of a suitable corrective is strongly recommended by all successful swine feeders.

Two dairy farms were selected for a study of the cost of producing milk. It was found that on one the cost of production was \$1.65 per hundredweight of milk; on the other farm the cost was \$6 per hundredweight.
