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Newspaper Laws.
We call the special attention of Post-
masters and subscribers to the following
provisions of the newspaper laws:

- 1. If any person orders his paper discon-
tinued, he must pay all arrears, or the
publisher may continue to send it until paid
arrearments made, and collect the same on
account whether it be taken from the office or not.
There can be no legal discontinuance until
payment is made.
2. Any person who takes a paper from
the post office, whether directed to his
name or another, or whether he has sub-
scribed or not is responsible for the pay.
