The Supplementaries.

The supplementary estimates which have been brought down by the Minister of Finance total \$2,647,628. These figures make the total somewhat in excess of last year's, but the increase is more than accounted for by the extraordinary expenditures required in the administration of the Yukon, the first cost of erecting necessary buildings and other expenditures imperative in the opening of such an absolutely new country and which have necessitated an outlay of \$1,130,054. While a total expenditure for the year of some \$43,000,000 is heavy, the fact must not be overlooked that the revenue has grown much more rapidly than the expenditure, and the Government, taking advantage of the elasticity of the public funds, the result of widespread national prosperity, are wisely utilizing the opportunity to push forward various works of public requirement which will be of inestimatable ther particulars. value in assisting and encouraging the opening up and further prosperity of the Dominion.


