### Dominion C. E. Convention.

The first Dominion Christian Endeavor Convention will be held in Montreal, beginning Thursday evening, Oct. 5th, and closing Monday night, Oct. 9th, 1900. The meetings will be held in the elegant and commodious St. James Methodist church, St. Catherine street.

A strong and enthusiastic local committee is making great preparations for this event and looking for a large number of delegates from all parts of the Dominion—especially Ontario, Quebec and the Maritime Provinces. The Secretary of Montreal '90 Committee is Mr. Guy Tombs, care of G. T. R., Board of Trade Building, of whom enquiry should be made for any information not found in the newspapers.

Single first-class fare for the round trip, from all stations in Canada, is the rate granted to delegates by all the railway companies. For further particulars, write to Mr. C. J. Atkinson, secretary Canadian Council of C. E., 26 Langley ave., Toronto.

Accommodation in the homes of citizens or in boarding houses, during the convention, can be secured at the uniform rate of fifty cents per night for lodging and twenty-five cents each for meals, by applying at once to the chairman of the Hotel Committee, Mr. J. H. Cayford, 207 St. James St., Montreal. Hotel accommodation may be had by those who prefer it, in good respectable places, at from \$1.50 to \$3.50 per day.

The program, which is arranged by the Canadian Council of Christian Endeavor, is very inviting and promises to be full of interest and profit to all who attend and very practical and helpful to C. E. workers. Various topics, under the heads of Christian Citizenship, Missions, Bible Study, Junior work, etc., will be discussed. Speakers are expected from each Province and at least two from the United States, namely, Rev. J. Wilbur Chapman, D. D., of New City, and Mr. J. Willis Baer, Secretary of the United Society of Christian Endeavor, of Boston. Both of these gentlemen are distinguished leaders in the C. E. movement, able and eloquent, and very beloved by Endeavorers. The former will conduct a "Quiet Hour" at the opening session on Thursday, Friday and Saturday. Much prominence will be given to Junior Christian Endeavor. On Saturday there will be a Junior Workers' breakfast and grand Junior rally; at the latter meeting there will be a display of young Canadian patriotism in connection with the children's exercises which are being prepared.

The Quebec and Ontario provincial unions will meet, separately, Saturday forenoon, for the transaction of annual business.
