

BOER PLOT DISCOVERED
To Capture Lord Roberts and Show All Officers

TEN CONSPIRATORS IN JAIL
Boers Retreating Ahead of Buller
De Wet Has Again Escaped
Hoare Had 300 Men With Him
A Complaint From Invalided Canadian

Pretoria Cable.—A plot to seize Gen. Roberts and to shoot as many as possible of the British officers here has been discovered. The conspirators were charged with having been arrested. Other suspects are being closely watched. It is expected that they will shortly be taken into custody.

The system of granting passes to Boers who take the oath of neutrality is proving unworkable, and there is urgent need of a stricter policy. Boers who have come into the city reports that the Boers are treating the natives brutally whenever they re-occupy a place that has been passed by the British troops. Their usual method of punishment is flogging.

Every night shots are heard round the town. The firing is done by the Boers, who frequently discover Boer emissaries trying to enter or leave the town.

The supplies here for the army are becoming scarce. The distribution of food is being interfered with. It is expected that trains will be available shortly, and the merchants will then replenish their stocks. The authorities are taking steps to prevent the sale of anything at three pence per pound. The indigent are still being fed with bread and other supplies.

Confirmed by Other Correspondents.
