Tough Dose, But Martin Luther Believed in Them.



Martin Luther says so These are his very words: 'Experience has proved the toad to be endowed with valuable qualities. If you run a stick through three toads, and, after having dried them in the sun, apply them to any pestilent humor, they draw out the poison, and the malady will disappear.' Pope Adrias always carried a bag about his neck containing dried toad, pearl, coral, gum tragacanth, smaragd, and other articles of junk. It did him a power of good, he said. It was all that kept him up.
