The agitation against the cigarette has taken on such widespread proportions in the United States that it is tolerably certain the traffic in these "coffin nails" must be seriously curtailed if not altogether abolished. An investigation just completed shows that the Legislature in at least thirteen States are considering the adoption of more or less drastic measures, that eleven States already have laws on their statute books prohibiting the sale of the paperwrapped weed, and that the W. C. T. U. and other organizations are urging the adoption of stringent legislation in half a dozen other commonwealths.

The most radical anti-cigarette measure yet proposed is now under consideration in the Minnesota Legislature, having been introduced by Senator Halverson, one of whose constituents recently died from smoking too many cigarettes.—Editorial in London Free Press.
