In hereas by "The Municipal Act of the province of Ontario. 1897 and the amendments thereto, any town way of a loan of money, exemption from Municipal taxes, etc., for the eufactures within its limits and may pay such sum or sums of money either in one sum or otherwise with or without interest and subject to such terms, conditions and restrictions as the said town may deem expedient and may take and receive security for the compliance with the terms and conditions upon which such aid is given:
