CO-OPERATIVE PACKING OF APPLES.

The English merchant does not like to handle small lots and experimental packages, says Mr. W. A. MacKinnon, Chief of the Fruit Division, Ottawa. He wants thousands of barrels, all uniform in quality, variety, packing and package.

APPLE BLIGHT.

A number of reports from widely separated districts, complaining of the ravages of the apple blight, have been received by the Fruit Division, Ottawa.

It is difficult to explain the origin of this trouble, but it is evidently of a bacterial nature. It appears to live over the winter just in the margin of the affected part, near the healthy wood, and not in other parts of the tree or in the soil.

As anything which stimulates an undue growth of succulent wood is conducive to blight, it would be well for the orchardist to cultivate and manure so as to produce a medium growth of strong healthy wood.

Trade was fairly brisk at the western cattle market for what cattle there were offering, but the run was generally of poor quality, very few really good cattle of any line being present.

Export Cattle—Extra choice cattle are wanted, and they may be quoted nominally at \$5 to \$6.125 per cwt. The ordinary run of choice cattle are about steady at \$4.60 to \$4.90, others run at \$2.60 to \$3.80.

to \$4.30 per cwt and stockers at \$2.50 to \$3.50 for common to light, and \$3.30 to \$4.70 for those of 700 to 900 lbs.

Milk Cows—The run was light, but the quality of the cows offered was fairly good. The range of prices is unchanged at \$80 to \$50 each.

Calves—A fair number were offered, but trade was steady and everything sold early. Prices are unchanged at 3 1/2 to 5 1/2 per pound and \$2 to \$10 each.

Sheep and Lambs—The run was fairly heavy, but sheep were wanted, and prices had a little firmer feeling.

Hogs—The run was lighter than it has been for some time, but prices are unchanged at \$6.25 for select and \$6 for lights and fats.
