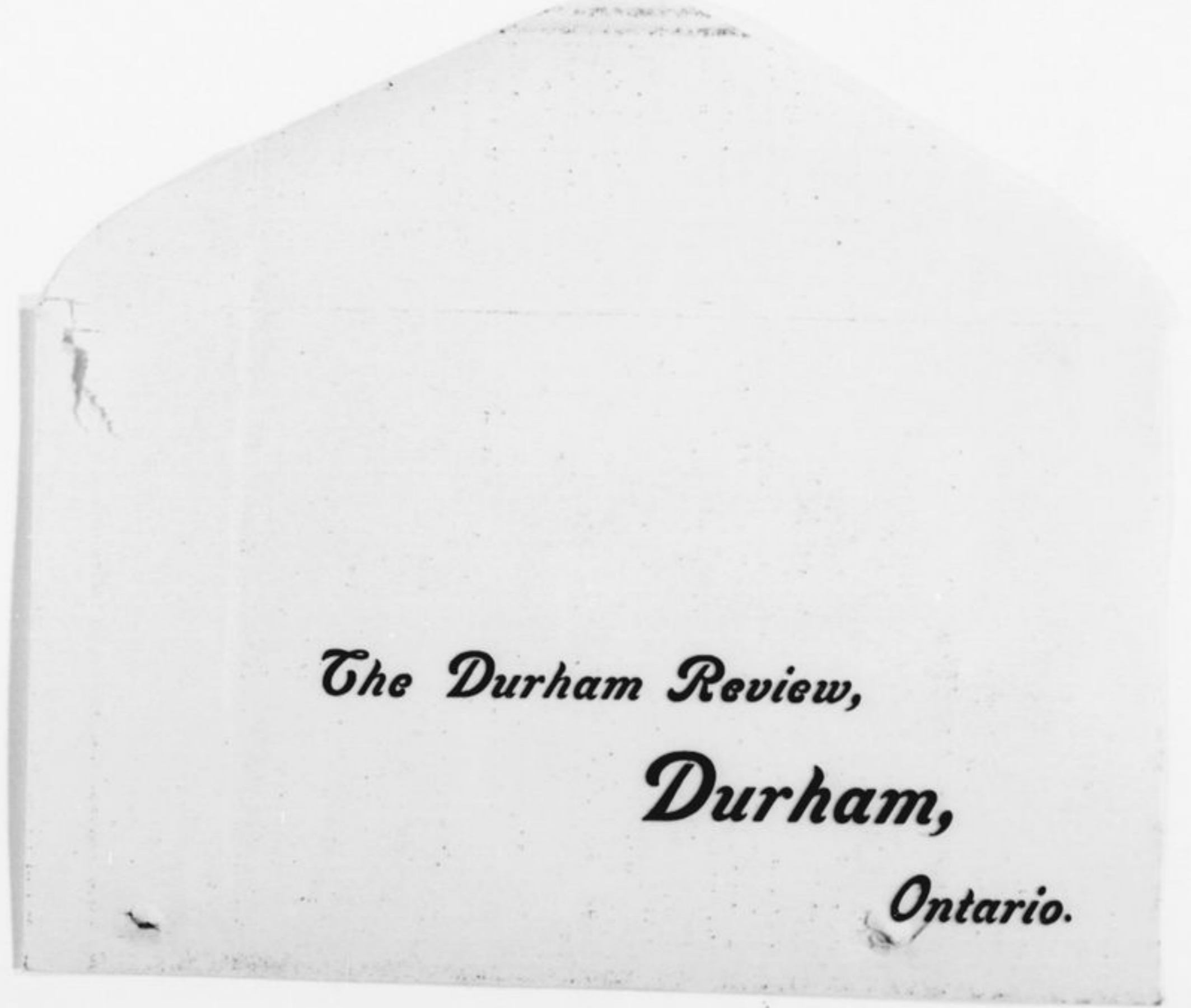
DEAR FRIEND :
