HINTS FOR BUTTER-MAKERS.

Food.—Supply cows with an abundance of wholesome food. Do not feed rape, turnip tops or apples. Do not allow cows to have access to ragweed, leeks, or other weeds which will taint the milk.

Water Supply.—Furnish pure water in clean troughs. Do not allow cows to drink from a stagnant pond or have access to soilage from barnyard.

Health of cows.—Salt should always be accessible. Stables should be well ventilated, lighted & drained; should have tight floors and walls and be plainly constructed.

Utensils.—Do not use wooden pails. Discard all rusty pails, cans or stirring utensils. Whey should be emptied as soon as it arrives at the farm.

Milkers.—Always wipe cows' udders, flanks, and teats before milking. Milk with clean and dry hands.
