Season's Prospects. So far as can be seen at the present time everything points to a very favorable season for the dairy man in 1905.

Dairy Organizations. The various organizations for promoting dairying were never so completely systematized nor so well managed as at present.

It would seem that the chief weaknesses of the dairy industry from the Farmer's view point are: 1—Not enough return, in some seasons, for labor and capital expended.
