NEWS IN BRIEF

Jewelry valued at \$4,000 was stolen from the new store of Rytie Brothers, at Toronto. Two ladies, supposed to be Americans, fell over a precipice near Orta, Italy, and were killed.

Dr. Clarke, of Rockwood Asylum, has been selected as Superintendent of the Toronto Asylum. The contract for dredging the harbor of St. John, N. B., has been awarded to Mr. G. T. Mayes.

All the Naptha works at Batu have been destroyed and all the factories and other works there are closed. A flawless diamond weighing 480 carats is reported to have been found in the Premier mine, Johannesburg.

Early to-day fire destroyed the business portion of Forestport, a village on the Black River Canal. Loss estimated at \$500,000.

Dispatch from Shanghai says that the deaths resulting from the recent floods in the low-lying districts were over 10,000.

Michael Croake, 31 Gloucester street, Toronto, was drowned on Tuesday near Halifax, in the Temuco district. Mr. Croake had gone north to investigate claims.

The substance of the new Anglo-Japanese treaty has been communicated by the British Foreign Office to the State Department at Washington, through Ambassador of Great Britain.

South Norwalk, Conn., Sept. 11.—Five East Norwalk fishermen crawled into port last evening, using the stumps of their oars as paddles and with one of their number unconscious in the bottom of the boat as the result of an attempt to catch the famous 610-pound log-head turtle which escaped from Captain Charles E. Ducross, a South Norwalk marketman, and which was the largest ever brought to Fulton Market.

MOROCCO BACKS DOWN; FRANCE IS SATISFIED. Paris, Sept. 11.—A despatch to the Foreign Office from M. St. Reme Tailandier, Minister to Morocco, announces that the Moroccan Government has yielded to the French demands and given complete satisfaction in the matter of the arrest of the Algerian-French citizen Boumazin.

Sultan Yields to Demands Regarding Arrest of Algerian-French Citizen Boumazin. The Grand Foreign Office from M. St. Reme Tailandier, Minister to Morocco, announces that the Moroccan Government has yielded to the French demands and given complete satisfaction in the matter of the arrest of the Algerian-French citizen Boumazin.

The Foreign Office was highly gratified this morning to receive the despatch from the French Minister at Fez, announcing that the Sultan had yielded all points demanded in the French ultimatum. The despatch says that Sept. 4, the day preceding the expiration of the ultimatum, the Grand Vizier, accompanied by a retinue, went to the French legation, where he received by the Minister and his Staff, and the leading European officials.

British Cattle Market. London—Cattle are quoted at 10 1/2 to 11 1/2 per lb.; refrigerator beef, 9 1/2 per lb. Toronto Live Stock. Considering the light rain, trade in fat cattle was slow at about the same prices as last Friday for the best grades, while the common classes were, if anything, lower in price.

Quebec: Groceries are moving fairly, but wholesale trade, as a rule, is reported quiet and country remittances very slow. In some sections harvest operations are pretty well over, but rain is badly wanted. Winnipeg: There is a good, healthy tone to all lines of trade here. Grocery stocks are moving well, although quotations are a little slow.

Victoria and Vancouver: Trade conditions generally are satisfactory. The demand for wholesale goods continues brisk, especially for northern parts of the Province, and heavy shipments of goods have been made during the past week or two. Retail trade is active. The big salmon run meant the distribution of large sums of money, which are not without their effect upon retail trade.

Hamilton: There is a fairly good movement to wholesale trade. Orders for fall goods are coming forward well, and country trade shows more activity. Collections continue fair to good.
