Use of Slade's tricks, and one which is little known, was exposed by Harry Keller, the American magician, after it had mystified hundreds of investigators. This was the trick of writing on a slate perfectly on both sides, and the medium would face with it and let committee hold it, while he still kept his hand on a corner of it.
