LARGEST CONCRETE WALL

Is Building Along Lake Front at Chicago.

One of the largest concrete walls ever constructed is building by the Illinois Central Railroad in connection with some lake-front park improvements.

The wall is 21 feet high and 6,250 feet long, measuring about 7 feet at the base and 18 inches at the top.

The top of the wall is finished by an attractive coping. It contains about 22,700 cubic yards of concrete, of which 18,000 cubic yards were laid in three months, when construction was stopped by cold weather.

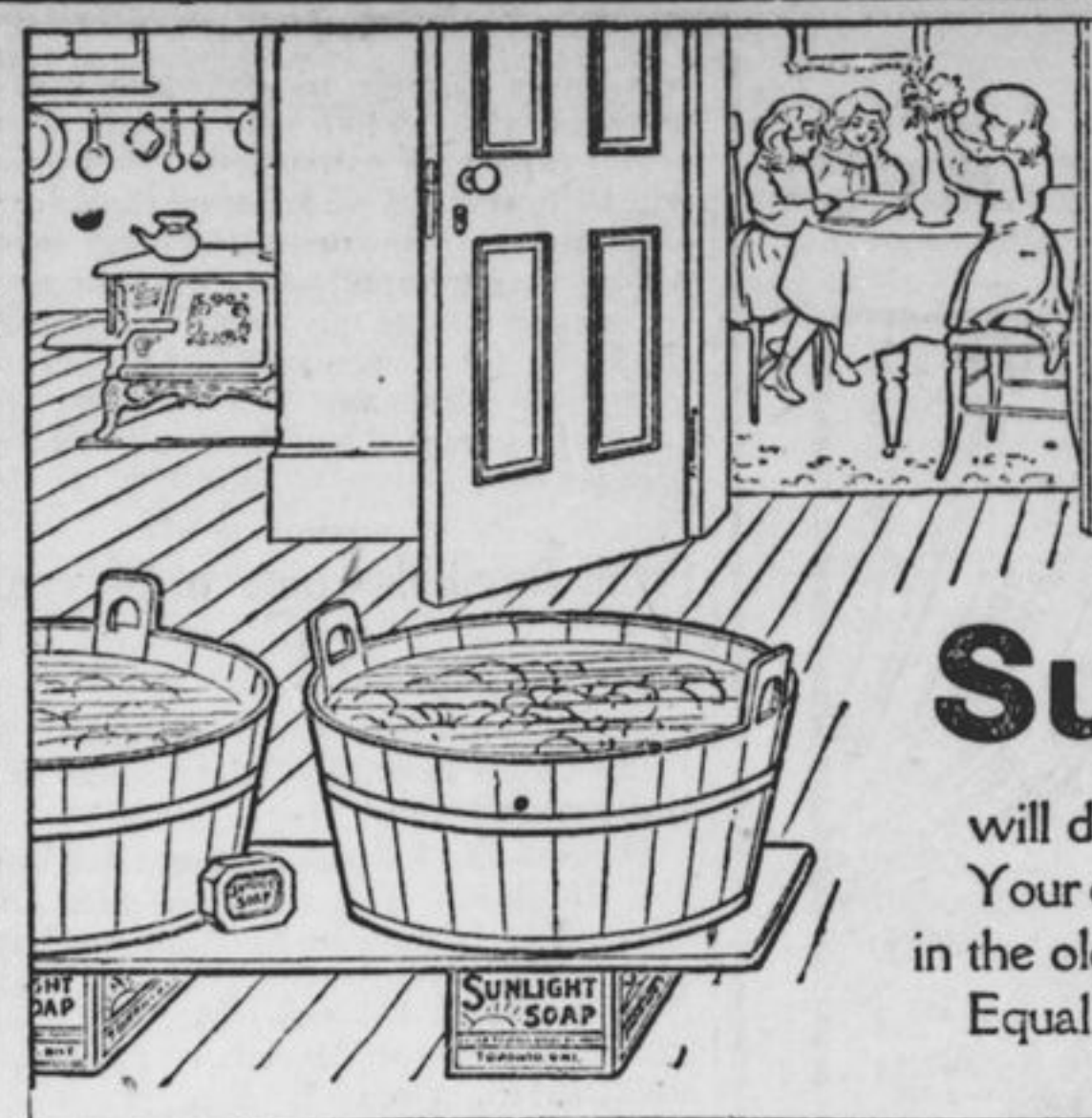
