SUPPORT HOME GROWN WHEAT

The fact of the steady decline in the demand for Ontario wheat must be a matter of concern not only to the individual wheat grower, but to the public generally. Ontario people have adopted the use of western flour to a considerable extent, and the building up of western industry to the detriment of the Ontario farmer and miller has been a serious economic loss to the province.

The Ontario farmer has not only lost a ready market for his wheat, but has suffered from the high prices of feed. When the business of wheat growing in Ontario was still flourishing the price of bran and shorts had not soared to the present figure of twenty to twenty-two dollars a ton.

There seems, however, to be no reason for regarding this state of affairs as inevitable. The Ontario wheat is conceded to have a flavor that is utterly lacking in the western flour, and were it not for the larger percentage of gluten in its western rival, it would have held its own in the open market for bread making as it still does for pastry, biscuits, etc.

Anything that will help to divert some of the money now turned into western channels ought to be welcomed by the farming community. The use of the Ontario blended flour will increase the market for the farmer and prove extremely beneficial to the dairyman by bringing down prices of bran and shorts to a more reasonable basis.

Summer Separations

The following is an extract only from a sensible article in the June Delineator: Long summer separations between husband and wife are unwise temporary divorces that often leave a long trail of sorrow, grief and misunderstanding.

When one member of the home firm takes a long solitary vacation and the other stays at home in loneliness, Cupid, though blind sees trouble ahead. With two who love each other the temporary separation may be the thin end of the wedge of permanent growing apart.

The regular annual exodus of the wife, because she has a restless desire to get away somewhere, because she has friends who insist on her accompanying them, or because she feels the neighbors will think she cannot afford to go away--these are the forms of voluntary separation for weeks and months that are dangerous and sometimes even prove a short cut from matrimony to alimony.

The theory that husband and wife should be separated occasionally so that they may appreciate each other the more is a dangerous doctrine. Vacations with each other may be new miniature honeymoons, bringing renewed love to both, but long vacations from each other are what the insurance companies term "extra-hazardous risks."

3 years in Penitentiary. This is the sentence imposed on Joseph Thompson conductor of the G. T. R. freight train which caused a wreck near Gourock last September killing three men. He admitted having slept on duty but claimed justification for having been at work for 20 hours.

"I am unable to see the slightest sign of repentance on your part. Instead of repentance for your own crime, you seek to cast all blame upon others. For your own sake, then, I must cause some substantial punishment to be inflicted."

"You knew you had, under the rules a rest of eight hours, once you had worked 16 hours, and there can be no doubt that you continued on the route because of its remunerative character. You stoutly asserted that you had plenty of sleep."

"To my mind, the persons who ever permitted you to work 19 and 20 hours a day--day after day--for five days in the week, were guilty of a gross wrong and I shall recommend to the crown authorities that the persons responsible, no matter what their position may be, be proceeded against so far as criminal law permits. It was wrong to punish an employe and allow the employe to go scot free where both are at fault."
