LETTERS TO THE EDITOR

Rev. Mr. Matheson Enjoys Muskoka Kaignashene Point, Muskoka Aug 2nd, 1907

Dear Review.--- We are glad to see you up here on your weekly visits and to learn from you what is going on in Priceville, Durham and other important places first hand as we could not always obtain it from the Toronto News, nor the Montreal Star.

In Glenelg and Artemesia townships Muskoka is considered a good distance away and it is a good deal further the way you have to travel to it, than the way the crows fly, but all the same when we leave Priceville in the morning we should be here in good time for supper.

The steamer for Kaignashene is called the "John Lee." She makes two trips daily omitting Wednesdays and Fridays and calls at the main tourist resorts by the way.

What a lot of drownings are taking place this year. Our position here makes us all very apprehensive, for the young who know no fear are in these parts as elsewhere.

1. A tract of land of irregular shape, being part of road allowance between Concession two and Concession three, south of the Durham Road, township of Glenelg, County of Grey, more particularly described as follows; BEGINNING at a point on the southerly limit of said road allowance, which point is two hundred and seven feet easterly from the westerly limit of lot thirteen, concession 3, south of the Durham road, when measured along said southerly limit of road allowance; thence north-easterly on a straight line whose course is N. 61 degrees, 41' E. a distance of one hundred and eighty feet; thence southerly along said southerly limit of road allowance, a distance of five hundred and eighty feet; thence southerly on a spiral curve to the right a distance of fifty feet; thence southerly on a curved line to the right having a radius of twenty eight hundred feet a distance of one hundred and fifty eight feet to the southerly limit of said road allowance; thence easterly along said southerly limit of said road allowance a distance of six hundred and five feet to the point of beginning; said tract of land containing nine tenths (0.90) acres more or less.

And for establishing a highway in lieu thereof, the following namely:
