Embe, \$975 in account of burnt sawmill; Geo. Hamel, \$200; Herbert Hunt, \$451 assessed for land he did not own; David Lamb, \$150; Chas. Mighson, \$50; W. Soarf, \$450; Robt. Wade, \$250; John McGilivray, \$100; D. Morlan, \$100.

There being no further appeals Court adjourned and met for the transaction of public business. Minutes of last meeting read and passed.

Wilson-Grierson-That the Treasurer issue a check to raise \$200 to meet a bill payable and he issue checks for timber and work on bridges on result of order from Reeve.

Noble-Wilson-That Henry Sabers be paid \$2 for use of building for council meeting.—Carried.

Wilson-Grierson-That the treasurer on behalf of the council present the clerk with \$10 in gold being the Anniversary of his Golden Wedding day.—Carried.
