Miller in the Limelight.

ans and they soon become Canadianized. The Doukhobors too are mostly well behaved. The only mistake made was in allowing them to settle in blocks.

The only immigrants now advertised for are farmers, farm laborers and domestic servants and each immigrant is required to have on landing at least \$25 cash and enough to purchase their ticket, thus shutting out all undesirable citizens. This immigration policy, chiefly directed to the West, was beneficial to Durham and Hanover industries as these new settlers were partly instrumental in creating the large market for furniture in the west.

Mr Miller then directed his attention to the expenditure, which had so greatly alarmed Mr Foster. He pointed out that the Government had spent more than the former Conservative administration, much more, but it was no extravagance to spend more if we received greater value for it. The government revenue had increased proportionately more than the expenditure. In 18 years of Conservative rule the public debt of Canada had increased \$118,000,000; from 1898 to 1907, 11 years of Liberal rule, the public debt had increased only \$5,174,427. In 1897, just after the Liberals had come into office, the average net per head in Canada was \$50.87; on March 30, 1908, it was only \$42.84, while Britain's was \$87. These figures speak eloquently for the business management of the country's finances. Particularizing, in the Post Office Department, the expenditure had increased under Liberal rule 50 per cent. Still the revenue had increased to a greater extent. In 1897 the Department was in debt \$585,839; in 1907 with a revenue of nearly 9 millions, the net gain was \$1,443,467.

The Railway Commission created by the present Government, was eulogized by the speaker as the most democratic, inexpensive and successful of any court in Canada. It had been a benefit directly to Durham in co-operating with the Mayor and council for C. P. R. crossing rights.

The Lord's Day Act was a great boon to 75,000 weary Canadian toilers, for whom it provided the Sabbath as the weekly rest day. Sir Wilfrid and the Minister of Justice were determined to do it and did see it through in the face of strong opposition from the railway, express and steamboat Co's, with the best results.
