Miller at Allan Park.

Tuesday evening Brigham's wagon shop was filled to the door to hear the most able parliamentarian in South Grey. ELECTIONS ARE ON.

Monday, October 26.
The government has fixed on the above date for the holding of the General elections. Nominations to be one week previous. Hence the contest will be brief and brilliant: "the hotter war the sooner peace."

This is the third appeal made by the Liberal party from the government benches. In 1896 they appealed from the shades of opposition and the country heard them and placed them in power. By many it was thought that the victory was a mere fluke, won by a catch cry, to be reversed at the first opportunity. In 1900 they made their first appeal on their record and the country said, "go on" with a majority larger than the first. In 1904 the second appeal was made and the country was even more decisive and gave them the largest majority ever.
