The Condition of India. Captain Fred Hunter's Views. Below will be found an interesting picture of India given by our townsman to the Manselton Journal in recent date. "Fred" has had more than usual opportunities of seeing the world, and he kept his eyes open is manifest. Our space will not permit of all appearing this week, but it is all interesting and will appear next week, though possibly our readers may not agree with all of his conclusions.

Three Among Millions. He looks like just the man to be placed with three other white men in a lonely Indian province, peopled by 12,000,000 natives, who feel none the kindly toward the British and where tact, diplomacy, fair treatment and valuable service are the only weapons of defence the whites have.

Morals are Rotten. Behind the superficial mask of intelligence, learning and vast ability, there is a rotten morality. They are extreme jingoists. These are the men you see coming to America to enlist and free India from the British rule, and they are able to convince people they are laboring in a just cause. And they obtain a great deal of money in Seattle, New York and other large cities. This money is being spent for terrible ends.

Teaches Self Government. For two centuries India has been a subject nation. It knows absolutely nothing of self government. The British are trying to teach self government to the Indians by letting them govern themselves to the extent that it is safe. Misguided members of the house of commons in England who make speeches denouncing British rule in India demand that India be freed, probably think they are doing the thing which they should do for a fellow being who wants his freedom from foreign rule. If they only knew that in so doing they are delaying India's freedom instead of advancing it, maybe they might desist. I believe the people who are laboring in India know best what is best for India, and that people who have not studied India at first hand know less than nothing about it.

Farm Laborers' Excursions. 20,000 Men Wanted for Western Harvesting. To meet the demand for farm laborers in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, special second class excursions will be run by the Canadian Pacific Railway from all Ontario stations. Cost of one-way ticket to Winnipeg is \$10.00, and from Winnipeg to points where laborers contract to work they will be carried without charge. After at least one month's work in the harvest field, a ticket back to Ontario standing points will be issued at \$18.00. Tickets are only valid for Farm Laborers' special trains. Tickets will also be issued to women, but no half-rate for children. Leaving dates of excursions are as follows: August 19th and Sept. 7th, from all stations on the line between Toronto-Toronto-Sudbury line and Toronto-Sarnia line of the Grand Trunk. August 23rd and Sept. 7th, from all C. P. and G. T. R. stations on Toronto-Sarnia line and south thereof (in Canada) and all stations in Ontario on M. C., P. M., and T. H. & B. R. August 27th and Sept. 10th, from all stations east of Toronto-North Bay line, to and including Kingston, also stations on C. O. and B. of Q. Rys. and stations on K. & P. south of Renfrew. For the three excursions in August special trains will be run. In all the points of the C. P. R. If you are in any doubt as to date of excursion from your district apply to local C. P. R. agent, who will also furnish times of special trains, or write to H. L. Thompson, District Passenger Agent, Toronto.

IMPERIAL DEFENCE CONFERENCE. One of the most significant conferences of recent times is the one on Imperial defence at present in session in London. Several distinguished British statesmen are in it, and Canada is represented by her Minister of Militia and Minister of Marine. All the Dominion have sent delegates to the meeting which has been called to discuss, perhaps to decide, what part they and the United Kingdom shall respectively take in the defence of the Empire. To taking some suitable part the Dominion in Parliament committed Canada last session, and after the return of the delegates with their report the matter will have to come before Parliament again for ultimate determination. In a question of this sort it has been deemed proper so far to hasten slowly, and this will probably continue to be the rule of procedure. There is no urgency through danger of war, and there are mixed feelings in Canada on the subject to be taken into account. If unanimity is to be secured, both the kind and the amount of her contribution will have to be carefully considered and frankly discussed. Fortunately, the present British Ministers are not alarmists, and there is room to hope for the best.—Pres.
