

MAN-MADE SPONGES.

Substance Obtained From Paper Treated with Zine Chloride.

When paper pulp is treated with zinc chloride there results a viscous mass. Sodium chloride (or ordinary table salt) is added to this. The mass is then thoroughly rinsed with alcohol, and is finally submitted to the action of a press whose platform bristles with a number of fine metallic points or projections. These penetrate the mass, forming tubes like those in an ordinary marine sponge known

as "canalicules." The block thus obtained is of a spongy consistency and is both insoluble and unalterable in water. It is smooth and pleasant to the touch, and is not susceptible of putrefaction. 
