BIG GOLD FIND IN INDIA.

Prince's Estate Found to be Rich With Deposits.

The London Daily Chronicle's Bombay correspondent states that a romantic discovery of mineral wealth on a vast scale is reported from an area covering 1,200 square miles in the Dalbhum district, about 150 miles from Calcutta. Extensive deposits of gold, copper, coal, iron, asbestos, mica, and manganese are said to have been located.

The estate of Prince Mahomed Buktear Shah, who died a month ago, is in the hands of an official receiver, who engaged an expert geologist, Phillip Billingshurst, of Vancouver, to survey the property and ascertain its value. Mr. Billingshurst asserts that the estate possesses immense quantities of from ore, some millions of tons averaging between 45 and 70 per cent. of metal. Several important gold finds are also reported.

The expert discovered a Santhali woman, reputed to be 110 years old, earning a competence by working free gold in a secret place she dissovered fifteen years ago. She was induced to disclose the source of her wealth by a present of a silk shawl and a few rupees, and the expert, sinking a trial shaft, found quartz yielding 139 ounces of gold to the ton. He says there are rich leaders and stringers of auriferous amounts and concludes:




