As Canada is likely to develop faster than its railways the subject of transportation is likely to continue a great problem. The grain production of the Canadian West is this year five times greater than it was ten years ago. In round numbers it was 100 million bushels ten years ago, and this year it is figured at 500 million bushels.
