

In Sweden the bridegroom has great fear of trolls and spirits, and as an antidote against their power he sews into his clothes various strong-smelling herbs, such as garlic and rosemary. It is customary to fill the bride's pocket with bread, which she gives to the poor she meets on the way to the church, and so averts misfortune with the alms she bestows. On their return from the church the bride and bridegroom visit their cow house and farms that the cattle may thrive and multiply.

The wedding ring as a symbol also dates to far-back times, probably having its origin in the days of Tubal Cain. It was at one time customary for marriage rings to be worn by both sexes, and this custom is largely followed on the continent to-day. Our ancestors put the ring on the left hand because they found it more convenient, and they chose the fourth finger because it is less used than the rest, and more capable of preserving the ring from damage.
