The boundaries of the universe have been discovered, according to a report received at the Nationa Observatory from Prof. R. T. A. Innes, director of the Union Observatory at Johannesburg, South Africa. The announcement is regarded with interest by astronomers all over the world.

The universe, Prof. Innes asserts, is contained within the space gird led by the Milky Way, and he figures that the most distant star in that wonderful girdle is 540 light years distant from the earth. 
