Another Sign of the Times

During the first three months of the current fiscal year—April, May and June—there was a drop of over \$7,000,000 in the customs revenue of the Dominion as compared with the revenue for the corresponding months of the preceding year.

With development works stayed as a result of the financial stringency, with industrial plants shut down or running part time only, with unemployment evident to an extent never before known in Canada, the purchasing power of the people has naturally and inevitably suffered a great reduction.

The Price Canada Pays

For the first time in a score of years, emigration from Canada is likely to exceed the number of newcomers entering the Dominion during the current fiscal twelvemonth.

Under the administration of Sir Wilfrid Laurier, there was increasing prosperity in Canada and a constant flow of desirable new settlers in a land which offered work and opportunity for all.

Under the administration of Sir Robert Borden, there has come industrial stagnation, an alarming slackening of Canadian prosperity, widespread unemployment accompanied by a steady increase in the cost of living.

The Government cannot escape the condemnation of the facts. Its reactionary tariff policy, its extravagance and inefficiency, has brought a complete reversal of the prosperous, progressive conditions which prevailed under Liberal rule.

Sex Centenary of Bannockburn

On the 24th June in the far gone year of 1814 there was fought a battle which for results has had few equals in the world.
