

The Kaiser's troops have done a great deal of destruction in Belgium, but it has been by means of their huge guns on solid bases, not by raining down bombs from above. From present appearances there is no great reason to apprehend an invasion of England by airships. They may, as Waldemar Kæmpfert thinks, blow up a building here and there, but they are not likely to acomplish a great deal more.
