Growing Importance of Finance

One of the most notable developments of this Session has been the unusual attention given to the question of finance and the unfavorable financial statement presented by the Government.

Mr. Rowell, among his other gifts, is a versatile genius for picking out the salient and important points in a financial statement and his review of the Government's position, on the close of the Budget Debate, was one of the most effective and deserved blows which the Ontario Government has received for a long time.

Mr. Rowell pointed out that where as in 1904 the public debt of the Province was only \$11,000,000, it is now \$40,000,000, an increase of 245 per cent.

The Government this year admits a deficit on the year's business of \$700,000, although their contributions to the war during the same period were less than \$300,000, but Mr. Rowell showed that if the accounts had been properly presented they would show that the actual deficit is \$4,200,000.

The Government had exercised even reasonable care in the public expenditure, the public debt would not have been so increased and the present deficit would not have occurred.

In other words it is the extravagance of the Ontario Government which has led to the necessity of the imposition of this tax of one mill on the dollar on all taxable property.
