War Notes

Germany has not yet replied to the stiff letter sent by President Wilson protesting against its barbarous methods that culminated in the sinking of the Lusitania.

The great event of the week is the entry of Italy into the war on the side of the Allies. Formal declaration was made on Sunday and fleet and army are on the move.

From the Kaiser down, Germany is filled with hate for Italy and in the meantime Britain is put in second place. Italy has taken possession of all enemy ships interned in her harbors.

The Dardanelles is not yet forced. Troops numbering about 100,000 are landed at various points and bombardment by the navy is proceeding with more care since they got their fingers burned in first attempt.

A daring deed has been done by a British submarine. About two weeks ago it traversed the Dardanelles, got to the sea of Marmora and during seven or eight days kept moving around, sunk five Turkish vessels.

The great German drive against Russia in Galicia was a notable victory for the foe, but latest accounts say the tables are turning and Russia is again on the offensive.

The pressure of the enemy around Ypres, where British and Canadians are, continues. The town is a heap of ruins and its capture would make little difference to the enemy except to make a boast of it.
