So great is the scarcity of the right dye, that it is said there will be practically no blue serge by the autumn, except in the warehouses of tailors who have had the foresight to buy in advance of their needs. Already the

price is up about fifty per cent. When indigo was first introduced into Europe no one would have it. The Germans themselves said that it was the "devil's dye," and called it "pernicious, corrupt, and corrosive." Both the English and French authorities forbade people to use it. In England the prejudice against the new dye was so keen that commissioners were appointed to go round to all places where it was likely to be found and destroy it.


