#### THE APPLE WORM

Most Destructive of the Insects That Attack Fruit

The common apple worm causes a greater money loss than any other insect that attacks fruit, destroying from one-fourth to one-half of the entire apple crop of this continent every

The average apple crop is about 50,000,000 barrels. Thus one is able to figure roughly the destruction accomplished by this abominable worm. The apple worm's mamma, from whose eggs the destructive larvae de-

velop, is the coddling moth. One cure for the mischief is to spray the trees with arsenical or other mineral posions. The worms eat the poisoned leaves and die. Thanks to this treatment, the choice grades of apples nowadays come to market in perfect condition, with no worm holes and no worms.


