HAREMS YIELDING STOLEN CHILDREN

NEAR EAST RELIEF RES-CUING WAR CAPTIVES.

Turks and Kurds Wait Withdrawal of Allies to Renew Outrages.

How 50,000 or more Armenian and Syrian children, stolen by Turks and Kurds and sold into harems or Arab encampments, are being rescued from captivity and worse through the efforts of the Near East Relief, now that the Near East is under allied rule, is told by the Rev. E. O. Jago, who has just returned from western Asia.

"It is no uncommon sight in Aleppo, Syria," says Mr. Jago, "to see scores of children brought in by the searching parties. The children are all dirty. raggd and starving, and many of them have been tattooed by their Arab mas-




