OUR CALENDAR

FEBRUARY, 1920, HAS FIVE SUNDAYS.

Persons Under Forty Years of Age Have Not Before Seen This Happen.

As this is leap year, the month of February contains twenty-nine days. As the month begins on Sunday, there are five Sundays. While about a fourth of the months contain five Sundays, it is an uncommon thing for February to have five. Since there are exactly four weeks in February in ordinary years, there can be five Sundays in the month in leap years only, and then only when the first day of the month falls on Sunday. Since the first day of the month can fall upon any one of the seven days of the week and since leap years are usually four years apart, it will be seven times four, or twenty-eight years, between the years in which there are five Sundays in February. The year 1900, however,


