United We Stand, Divided

A meeting in Toronto last week, called by the Referendum committee, was attended by J. W. Dwyer, President of South Grey Com. and by Messrs Allan Bell and Dr Wolfe. As far as can be seen it has not cleared off the unfortunate division between Andrew S. Grant, head of the Referendum committee and Ben H. Spence, Secy of the Ontario Alliance. The former would take the Ottawa politicians at their word and petition through the Legislature for the necessary referendum. The latter is afraid of loop holes that would render negative a successful vote if taken unless the Legislature abolishes the licenses now granted for the sale of native wines, which are admittedly intoxicating.

The Dominion Referendum applies to provinces which have "abolished by license the sale of intoxicating liquors as a beverage." Spence claims the licensing the sale of native wines, shuts out this province; Grant and his followers have no such fears and proved themselves splendid organizers in the last campaign.

We think it is plainly a case of jealousy between the two organizations as to who is to conduct the final campaign. The chances of abundant success are greatly lowered by having a division of the forces. It is hinted that Spence is piqued over some apparent slight, all of which we think makes it desirable that both men withdraw and let new leaders be appointed who will work in harmony.

However, on its own merits, we think the licensing for sale as a beverage of native wines, which show 20 per cent or over of proof spirits, should be abolished and we hope the D.ury government will take this view.

—Angus McDonald's (the farmer-labor candidate) majority in Temiskaming is now over 2000.

—Speaker Parliament at Toronto has decided that the \$5000 indemnity for Opposition Leader should this year be divided between Hartley Dewar and Mr G. Howard Ferguson, leaders of the small bands of Grats and Tories respectively.

—The Ottawa Government has a second time given assurance that it cannot accept the principle of a cash gratuity to returned soldiers. For 2 reasons: (1) It is not the best way to re-establish soldiers in civil employment. (2) The finances of the country could not stand it as it would cost an indeterminate amount of from \$100,000,000 to \$1,000,000,000.

—Some statistician has figured out that the salaries of machinists, painters, carpenters, &c. have increased from 50 to 80 per cent, while those of Methodist ministers have increased only 7 per cent. Something wrong.
