### Electric Rain Alarm.

Falling rain is likely at any time to drive into a room and damage the floor, wallpaper and furnishings. One manufacturer has devised an electric rain alarm which will give warning as rain in any quantity falls into a room. The device consists of a box containing a battery, a buzzer, a small electric light and a switching arrangement that holds what the maker calls a "raino-disc." The box is put on the window sill at night when the window is left open for ventilating purposes. The falling rain drops on the disc, switches on the current and throws both light and buzzer into circuit. The buzzer awakens the sleeper and the light shows which window needs attention.


