Canada is a nation and an experiment and an achievement. And she is something more. She is an inspiration. When the Fathers built up the 147 sections of the British North America Act, sixty years ago, they laid the foundations of the first federation within the British Empire. Never before had the federal principle and the British Constitution been linked together and there was some doubt as to whether they would work in union.


