Shanghal-Suppression of piracy at Blas Bay, notorious lair of Chinese pirates who long have defied every authority, is the first job that the new Cantonese government has set for

Foreign dispatches from Canton recently stated that the Canton group of Nationalists which started a few days ago to establish a new Cantonese government independent of all other nationalist regimes, is preparing its plans rapidly and is taking an active hand in Cantonese adminis-

As an indication of the group's in tention of operating independently of its erstwhile colleagues at Manking, it was announced that the 30,000 Cantonese soldiers now proceeding toward Hankow to aid the Nanking resime in throwing out Gen. Tang Sengthi, will be called back to Canton.

"When the ideal conditions exist between capital and labor there is no need for a third party to intervene," said Austin. "Therefore when cooperation between capital and labor reaches a high point and it is making progress in both this country and in England, it will not be necessary for workers to organize into labor unions. In time I believe the unions will pass out from lack of use. This has happened largely in the Mitten organization. There the men settle their trouble directly with the management."

He said the unions were organized as a combative unit and as the co operation between capital and labor increased there was less and less need for conflict.
