New British Speed Boat Being Built

Estelle IV. Will Be Shipped to Montreal Next Month

90 MILES AN HOUR

Montreal.-That the much-coveted Harmsworth Trophy for motor boat racing will be held by an English woman after the first week in September is the firm opinion of Herbert Ditchburn, one of the best known speed and pleasureboat builders on this side of the Atlantic, who, with Mrs. Dutchburn, landed recently from the Cunarder "Andania" following an extensive tour of Europe.

While in England, Mr. Ditchburn inspected Miss Betty Carstair's "Estelle IV.," her new racing craft which is now nearing completion and with which she hopes to wrest the valuable trophy from the Americans.

The new craft, said Mr. Ditehburn, has been designed by A. H. Hawker, an Englishman with considerable Canadian experience in boat-building, and will be capable of a speed of over 90 miles an hour. The type of engine used will be the Napier Lion, similar to that used by Sir Henry Seagrave in his Golden Arrow when he covered 231 miles an hour on Daytona Beach recently, though the actual number of engines and the horsepower developed is still a secret.

Mr. Ditchburn explained that England is at a disadvantage where trials are concerned, owing to the fact that the engines are fitted with very thin steel water jackets tests can not be made in salt water and there are no fresh water lakes in Great Britain large enough for such a high speed. Accordingly arrangements have been made for the Estelle IV to be shipped to Montreal on a Cunarder early next? month and on arrival here it will be transhipped by rail to Gravenhurst, Ont., where it will be put through its trials over Muskoka Lakes before entering the international race at Detroit on Labor Day. At the same time Miss Carstairs will arrive in New York on the Cunarder Berengaria and proceed to Gravenhurst.

While at Gravenhurst, said Mr Ditchburn, the British representative will be able to take advantage of the extensive body of water there and will also have the co-operation of the Ditchburn Yards at Gravenhurst. 
