#### THE ELECTION APPROACHES

The prime minister of Canada accepted the statesmanlike course of taking Parliament and the public in to his confidence as soon as he had made up his mind as to the time of a general election. He did not keep the country guessing after he had reached a decision nor resort to secrecy to cover up preparations for the contest in the hope of stealing a march on his opponents. He has given them ample warning. Mr Bennett asked for an election on the issues of the Budget and he will have it whether he wants it or not. Having invited it, he cannot refuse the prime minister's proposal of co-operation in winding up the business of the session, so that the appeal may be made as soon as possible, obviously before the Imperial Conference in mid-September.

The government can appeal to the electors on its record, but what will be the Conservative party's battleground? even its battle cry? The plan of campaign mapped out by its board of strategy was freely advertised. There was nothing original or inspired in it—it was a revival of old methods and tactics. Mr Bennett had repeatedly sounded the keynote in his frequent speeches in the country and in the House. The stage was set for an orgy of anti-Americanism as in 1911. The government was to be denounced as a satellite of Washington, sacrificing Canadian industry and agriculture by encouraging a flood of imports from the United States and too poor in spirit or too compromised to protect the interests of this country when they were threatened by the tariff legislation of Congress. The flag was to be waved as a matter of

course and the Conservative party depicted as the allies of the Beaverbrook movement in Great Britain and the champion of intra-Empire trade.

All these stage properties have been rendered useless by the Dunning budget and Mr Bennett and his followers are acutely embarrassed and look somewhat ridiculous. They cannot sing the old songs now and they cannot wave the flag. They must improvise new tunes and find a new oriflamme. Mr Bennett is so perplexed that in one breath he accuses the government of stealing his policy and in the next declares the budget was made at Washington.

The Dunning budget is the complete and crushing reply to Conservative propaganda and has demolished the Conservative election program.

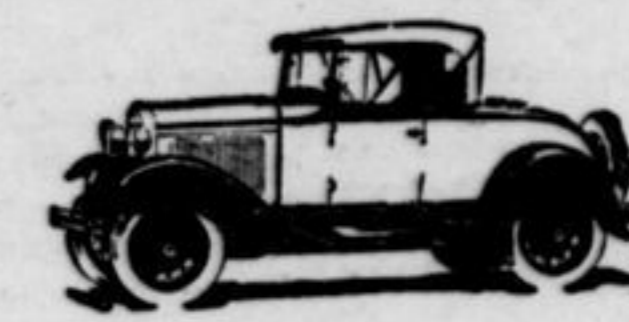

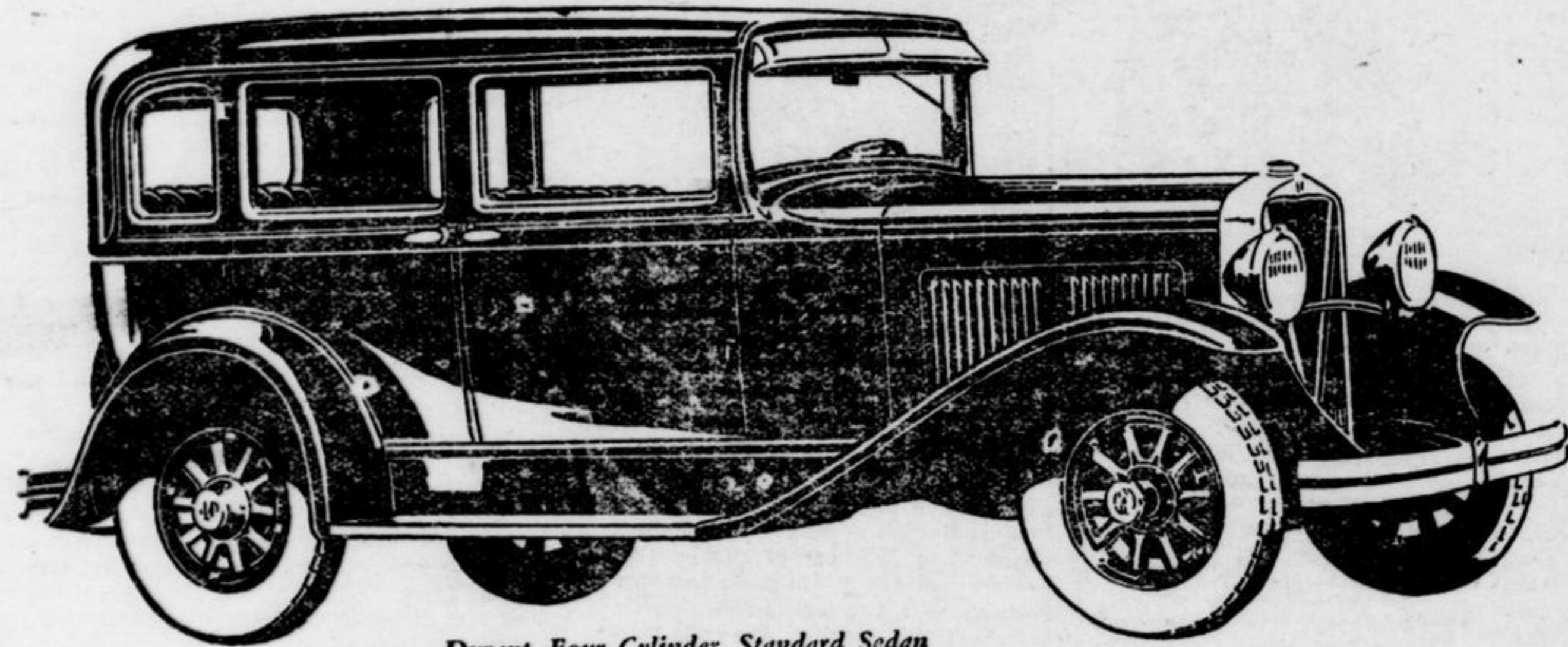
