For the child who has developed anaemia after a bout of whooping cough, rickets, bronchitis or similar weakening disease, injections of iron directly itno the lining of the abdominal cavity are beneficial, Drs. Clifford and Grulee, of Chicago, reported. Treating this secondary anaemia with iron has formerly been a tedious process, iron taken by mouth or injected into the arm or a vein does not regenerate the blood very quickly. The new method, which is supplemented by ultraviolet ray treatments, gave good results on a group of six young children. They all gained weight and improvement was still in evidence eight months after the treatment. The method has no effect in primary anemia or pernicious anemia, Dr. Grulee emphasized.

Planes Have Far to Go?
