More Research Work With such activity in rocket research there can be little doubt that we are on the way to the development of a rocket motor that will at least be practical for meteorological work.

But there are, nevertheless, things which can be accomplished with a rocket motor that can be accomplished in no other way. It is safe to say that some of these things will be done in the present generation.



"Rain" From a Cannon

An ingenious device known as th "rain cannon," used for watering fields, was displayed at Hanover, Germany. It consists of a jet mounted on a cylindrical pressure tank. The water until there is equillibrium. When this is attained a valve located in the nozzle opens an orifice. Owing to the sudden release, the air pressure ejects the water in a powerful jet and throws it a considerable distance and at the same time moves it around

This method is considered a great improvement on the old sprinkler and pipe-line methods. A small rain cannon, requiring only a pressure of two of three atmospheres, is finding a ready market.
