Mt. Wilson Mirror The U.S. Navy's airship Akron, the largest in the world, may be pressed into service to carry to California the glant 200-inch telescope girror soon to be constructed in an Eastern work shop. When this mighty disk of quartz is completed, probably within two years, its transportation to the telescope site will be a major engineering problem, says "Popular Science Monthly." It is too large to be carried safely on a train. University of California scientists have suggested that the Akron might pick up the mirror at the factory and deposit it on the still unselected mountain peak near Pasadena, Calif., where it will be used.




